THE QUESTION: What Can I Do? THE POINT: There are lots of people who need your help.
Acts 9:36-43; Matthew 25:31-40; Matthew 10:42

TALKING POINTS

We don't have to look far to discover needs that we can help meet.

Begin looking for needs of those whom you already know.

Ask yourself how you can help them and how you can pray for them.

Meeting the needs of strangers brings honor to God.

We will be held accountable for whether or not we meet other people's needs.

There are multiple ways to meet the needs of strangers in your community.

Serving others doesn't always have to be big acts of service.

Servant evangelism begins with small and simple acts of service.

What are the benefits of meeting needs of someone you don't know?
